

PURCHASE ORDER ATTACHMENT Q-132

ELECTRICAL, ELECTRONIC AND ELECTROMECHANICAL (EEE) PARTS COUNTERFEIT AVOIDANCE AND DETECTION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Seller shall be one of the following:
 - a. An authorized or franchised distributor
 - b. The Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM)
 - c. The Original Component Manufacturer (OCM)
 - d. An aftermarket manufacturer authorized by the OEM or OCM
- 2. Authorized or franchised distributors must provide documented traceability of the parts to the OEM or OCM. Traceability requirements may be met by providing a Certificate of Conformance or documentation from the manufacturer that includes lot date code information.
- 3. Aftermarket manufacturers must provide evidence of OEM or OCM authorization.
- 4. Seller shall implement an approach to counterfeit detection and avoidance meeting the requirements of AS5553, revision in effect at time of Buyers purchase.
- 5. Seller shall insure these requirements are flowed to all sub tier suppliers providing parts and materials required to complete Buyers Purchase Order.
