Seller's Quality Management System Requirements

- 1. Seller's quality system shall be in compliance with ISO 9001, latest revision.
- 2. Acceptable evidence of compliance shall be a current copy of a recognized third party certification.
- 3. A quality system registered to AS9100 by a recognized registrar, or any other quality standard derived from and containing the full text of ISO 9001 may also be used.
- 4. Buyer, and authorized Government Representatives if a government contract is involved, reserve the right to enter Seller's facilities, and those of Seller's suppliers at every tier, that may be engaged in work relating to the Purchase Order, for the purpose of surveillance/inspection of the Seller's (and Seller's suppliers') processes, controls, quality records and systems, as well as supplies/services procured under the Purchase Order.
- 5. Surveillance/inspection of Seller's processes and controls, and supply chain will not constitute acceptance of the materials/supplies/services being procured.
- 6. The Seller shall ensure that requirements in Buyer's purchasing documents are flowed down to sub-tier suppliers.
- 7. The Buyer's purchasing requirements include, but are not limited to, compliance by Seller with the applicable sections of the ISO 9001 Quality Management System and any additional characteristics as required.
